Doctors Hill Road Hillclimb

14th October 2018

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Clubsport Advanced event, promoted by the Northland Car Club Inc.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all Clubsport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A (except for pre 78 Schedule K-T and C or CR vehicles that are in compliance with Appendix 6 Schedule AA)

This is a clubsport Advanced event and open to members of Motorsport New Zealand affiliated clubs.

3. VENUE

The event will be held on Doctors Hill Road, a well formed public tarseal road of approximately 1.3km in length.

Doctors Hill Rd is 25km south of Whangarei off S.H.1 at Ruakaka, 1km south of Marsden Point Road turn off on right, 800m to roadside pit area before second bridge.

4. ENTRY CLOSING DATES, ENTRY FEES & ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY:

4.1 Entry Closing Dates

Entries will be accepted on the day at documentation at the venue.

4.2 Entry Fees

The entry fee will be \$80.00.

Late entry fee after 9am, add 50% to entry fee unless organiser advised prior to ending of documentation.

No entries will be accepted once Drivers briefing commences.

4.3 Classes A: 0 -1300, B: 1301 – 1600, C: 1601 – 2000, D: 2001+ and E: 4WD

5 COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS & UNDERSTANDING:

5.1 Licence Requirements

The driver must hold a **CIVIL DRIVERS LICENCE and M GRADE MOTORSPORT LICENCE**

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

You will need to be a member of the Northland Car Club (24hrs prior to the event) or a member of another affiliated Motorsport NZ club.

5.2 Competitors Briefing

A drivers briefing will be held at the venue for all competitors(at start line or beside NCC van), please be ready for recce run immediately following.

5.3 New Drivers

Any driver(s) who have not previously competed at this type of event must indicate the fact at documentation and attend the New Competitors Briefing session. This briefing will be straight after the Drivers Briefing.

5.4 Competitor understanding

In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules.

In particular:

The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and Appendix 5 (Clubsport), Schedule C (Clubsport) paragraph 4 to 7 inclusive. Appendix 2 (Safety), Schedule A (Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements)

5.5 Underage Competitors

Not able to enter this event due to road being closed under Transport Regs instead of 10th schedule.

N/A Under age drivers (12 – 15years) with an “authorized minor” competition licence **must be supervised by a passenger who has held a full civil drivers licence for a minimum of two years.**

5.6 Fuel

Competitors are reminded of the “Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel – Storage and Handling” handbook for safety in handling fuel.

5.7 Passengers

It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure that all passengers sign the indemnity form prior to participation. (at the Club Van) and they are wearing the correct safety clothing etc...

5.8 Tyres

NO slick (racing) tyres.

5.9 Touring

Competing cars with WOF & rego are required to tour back to the start via Mountfield Rd (left after roadblock) to S.H.1 approx 5km. Those without wof/reg will be able to return to the start via the course (Road clearance after each run will be by the nominated driver of the last returning vehicle.also by radio Contact with course Marshalls)

6. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

6.1 Documentation

Will take place at the venue, commencing at 8:00 a.m. and concluding at 9.00 a.m.

All documentation to be completed and brought back up to the yellow NCC van with all licences, membership card, log book and entry fee by 9.00am.

6.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection

These inspections will occur concurrently with documentation.

During the documentation process you will be advised whether your vehicle is to be subjected to audit. You should assume that your vehicle is going to be subjected to audit and as a consequence is in readiness to be audited immediately after you have concluded documentation.

7. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event should it be found impossible to run the event due to circumstance beyond our control which lead to either the venue being unable to be used or any articles in the Safety Plan cannot be implemented.

The Organisers also reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions in the National Sporting Code.

For reasons of Force Majeure should a meeting or part thereof be cancelled any entry fee refund will be made only at the discretion of the organisers.

8. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

9. DRIVING BEHAVIOUR

All competitors will heed the instructions from Officials or be dealt with by the Clerk of the Course.

There is to be no driving up and down the public road warming up brakes, tyres or the like, if a competitor is caught doing anything of the like they will be excluded from the event.

- There will be no food or drink available at the venue
