SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

GLENBERVIE FOREST HILLCLIMB

24th November 2024

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Clubsport Advanced Event promoted by the Northland Car Club Inc.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A, Schedule K, T&C or CR vehicle that are in compliance with Appendix 6, Schedule AA.

This is a clubsport advanced event and is open to members of Motorsport New Zealand affiliated club.

3. VENUE:

3.1 The event will be held at Marua Road, within the Glenbervie Forest, a well formed gravel forestry road of approx 2.0km's in length.

Entry to the forest is from Main Road - this is off Vinegar Hill Road, Kauri, Whangarei.

4. ENTRY CLOSING DATES, ENTRY FEES and ACCEPTANCE of ENTRY:

4.1 Entry Dates:

All such entries must be made on the correct form, must be complete in all detail, and accompanied by the appropriate fees.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

Online entries close for this event at 6pm Thursday the 21st of November.

Entries will be accepted on the day at documentation at the venue until 9am.

An online induction needs to be completed prior to the day- this is a requirement that we need to follow and will be checked on the day. A link is on the entry form accessed through Motorsport NZ and is below

4.2 Entry Fees The entry fee will be \$120.00

Late entry fee after 9am, add 50% to entry fee unless the organiser advised prior to ending of documentation.

No entries will be accepted once Drivers briefing commences.

4.3 Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

2WD - A: 0 - 1300 B: 1301 - 1600 C: 1601 - 2000 D: 2000+

4WD - E

XC - CrossCar

SP - Special

Please Note: No Electric or Hybrid vehicles can compete due to our current permit conditions.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

5.1 Licence Requirements:

The driver must hold an M GRADE COMPETITION LICENCE as a minimum.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

You will need to be a member of the Northland Car Club (24hours prior to the event) or a member of another affiliated Motorsport NZ club.

5.2 Competitors Briefing:

A drivers briefing will be held at the venue for all competitors at start line or beside NCC van. Please be ready for recce run immediately following.

5.3 New Drivers:

Any driver(s) who have not previously competed at this type of event must indicate the fact at documentation and attend the New Competitors Briefing session. This briefing will be straight after the Drivers Briefing.

5.4 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and Appendix Five, Schedule C (Clubsport) paragraph 4 to 7 inclusive.

5.5 Underage Competitors:

Under age drivers (12– 15years) with an “authorised minor” competition licence must be supervised by a passenger who has held a full civil drivers licence for a minimum of two years.

5.6 Fuel

Competitors are reminded of the “Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel– Storage and Handling” handbook for “safety in handling fuel”.

5.7 Passengers:

Passengers may only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.

It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure that both themselves and all their passengers sign the individual indemnity forms prior to participation (at the Club Van) and they are wearing the correct safety clothing etc.

5.8 Tyres

NO slick tyres allowed. Gravel tyres permitted.

5.9 Touring Cars will return to the start via the course after each run.

6.0 DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

6.1 Documentation: Will take place at the venue, commencing at 8:00 a.m. and concluding at 9.00 a.m.

All documentation to be completed and brought back up to the yellow NCC van with all licences, membership card, log book and entry fee by 9.00am.

6.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection:

These inspections will occur concurrently with documentation.

During the documentation process you will be advised whether your vehicle is to be subjected to audit. You should assume that your vehicle is going to be subjected to audit and as a consequence is in readiness to be audited immediately after you have concluded documentation.

7. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS’ RIGHTS:

The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event should it be found impossible to run the event due to circumstances beyond our control which lead to either the venue being unable to be used or any articles in the Safety Plan cannot be implemented.

The Organisers also reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions in the National Sporting Code. For reasons of Force Majeure should a meeting or part thereof be cancelled any entry fee refund will be made only at the discretion of the organisers.

8. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY:

All vehicles complying with Appendix 5 Schedule C Article 4, Paragraph 4.1. 9.

9. DRIVING BEHAVIOUR:

All competitors will heed the instructions from Officials or be dealt with by the Clerk of the Course. There is to be no driving up and down the public road warming up brakes, tyres or the like, if a competitor is caught doing anything of the like they will be excluded from the event.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- No dogs are allowed at the venue.
- All your rubbish is to be cleaned up and taken home with you.
- There will be no food or drink available at the venue.
- Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.
- Damage: Competitors are required to report any damage they cause to stock or property to any official. All drivers will be liable for any damage that they cause to public or private property. Excess on the Motorsport NZ insurance cover is \$3500.00 payable by the competitor.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

10.1 Passengers: May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.

10.2 Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.

10.3 All competitors are required to leave the area tidy and take your rubbish with you. NCC competitors are required to bring rake or shovel to tidy the road if needed.

10.4 PLEASE NOTE: All competitors/marshalls and helpers will need to complete an online induction prior to entering the forest - this will need to be completed at documentation.

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
